- **What:** Groundwater monitor well, used to collect water levels and groundwater samples for laboratory analysis.
- **Where:** City of Goodyear property at 14000 West Yuma Road.
- **When:** Construction activities are scheduled to begin July 25, 2016 from approximately 6 a.m. to 5 p.m.; construction activities can last two weeks total with the drilling lasting about one week.
- **How You May Be Affected:** Businesses and residents should expect some noise during the construction activities and are asked to abide by the traffic signs and barricades in the area. Efforts will be made to cause the least disruption to businesses and residents. A chain-link fence may surround the work area during construction for safety purposes.

History: Crane Co., the owner of the former Unidynamics facility on Litchfield Road, is ordering the testing of the groundwater to determine the impact of chemical disposal practices decades ago at the former defense industry facility.
