Van Buren Street, Suite B101 (southeast corner of 145<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Van Buren Street), Goodyear, Arizona, for the purposes of conducting a hearing on the District Budget attached hereto as *Exhibit A* and incorporated by reference herein, and tax levy; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Title 48, Section 716, Arizona Revised Statutes, and following public notice, the District Board met on June 7, 2021, at which hearing any taxpayer in the District was privileged to appear and be heard in favor or against any of the proposed expenditures or tax levies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE KING RANCH COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT (CITY OF GOODYEAR, ARIZONA) that the District Budget in the amount of \$4,200 is hereby adopted as the District Budget of the District for fiscal year 2022.
