

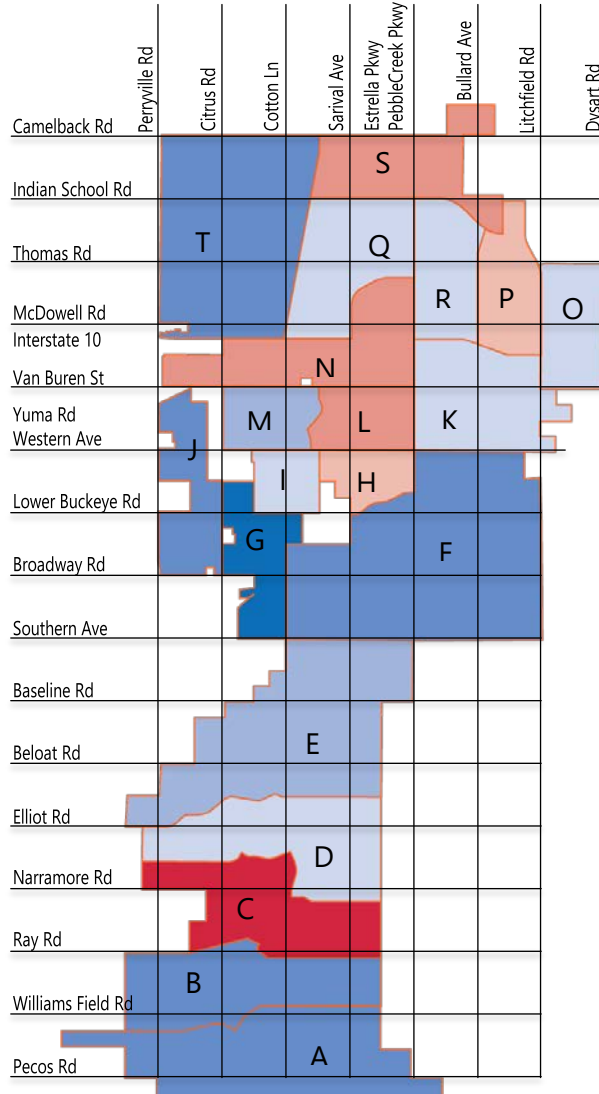
# BULK TRASH COLLECTION

## ONE DAY PER MONTH SERVICE

- Bulk trash includes items that are too large and bulky to fit in the trash container such as tree limbs, brush, furniture, and appliances.
- City ordinance allows bulk trash to be placed up to seven days prior to the scheduled collection day. Placing bulk material out at any other time is a violation of city ordinance and may result in a citation. Check with your homeowners association for any additional specific requirements regarding bulk trash.  
**To determine monthly pickup day, refer to the map or visit [goodyearaz.gov/trash](http://goodyearaz.gov/trash) to use the Solid Waste Service Calendar.**
- Place bulk trash in the street, next to the curb, parallel to the street, in front of the property, by 6 a.m. on collection day.
- DO NOT place bulk trash on driveways, sidewalks, electrical boxes, cable boxes, mail boxes, light poles, water meters, landscape, or where it may be a hazard to pedestrians or vehicles.**
- Items should be in boxes or tied in bundles. Each box or bundle cannot exceed 50 pounds in weight (except appliances and furniture). Brush cannot exceed 4 feet in length. Trash cannot exceed 5 cubic yards (about the size of two pickup truck beds).
- Grass clippings must be bagged.
- Materials with a cutting edge or point, such as glass or cacti, must be securely contained.
- It is the resident's responsibility to clean up small debris that may remain after collection.

### NOT Allowed for Bulk Collection

Household waste, hazardous materials, tires, oil, large auto parts, vehicles, rocks, dirt, sod, roofing, drywall, concrete, and construction materials. Items exceeding proper size will not be collected.

# CITY-OBSERVED HOLIDAYS

## COLLECTION SCHEDULE

There will be no solid waste collection service on the city observed holidays listed below. Following each holiday, pickup will switch to the day after the normal scheduled pickup day.

Examples: If the holiday is on a Monday, pickup begins on Tuesday of that week. If the holiday is on a Thursday, then Thursday's pickup will take place on Friday, and Friday's pickup will take place on Saturday.

### City-Observed Holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Independence Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

# TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION

## WEEKLY – SAME DAY SERVICE

- Tan garbage containers and green recycling containers may be placed out no sooner than 6 p.m. the night before your designated collection day and must be placed out no later than 6 a.m. on your collection day.
- Place containers on the street, with wheels against the curb. Leave at least 4 feet between containers. Place containers at least 5 feet away from vehicles and other objects.
- Do not overfill containers.
- Bag and tie all garbage.
- **DO NOT bag recyclables.**

### What to Recycle

- Paper: office paper, envelopes, junk mail, newspapers, magazines, telephone books, paper bags.
- Glass bottles and jars (rinse lightly to clean).
- Plastics #1 – #7 (please check for the chasing arrows recycling symbol; rinse lightly to clean these items): bottles, bottle caps, packaging, cups, food containers.
- Aluminum/steel/tin cans (rinse lightly to clean).
- Cardboard/chipboard: office supply boxes, cereal boxes (clean, empty and broken down).
- Cartons: milk, juice, creamer (rinse lightly to clean).

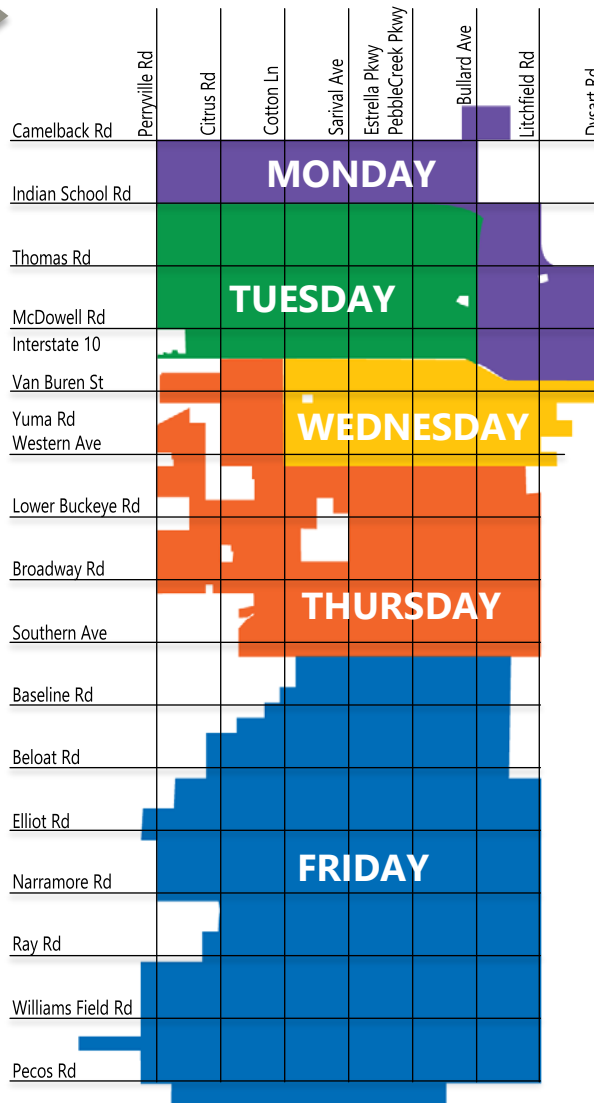
### What NOT to Recycle

**Plastic bags**, rocks, dirt, blocks, bricks, concrete, drywall, paint, thinners, gas, oil, car batteries, tires, tree limbs, packing popcorn, **pizza boxes**, clothing, grass, wood, electronics, aluminum foil, hard-bound books, tissues, napkins, paper towels, paper plates, shredded paper, foil wrapping, waxed paper/boxes, windows, mirrors, broken glass, and household hazardous waste.

County law requires that grass, food, diapers, bathroom and sanitary waste, animal waste or any other wet garbage be placed in plastic bags and tied and sealed.

This helps to eliminate odors, fly breeding, and other pest problems.



# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

It is unlawful for any individual or business being compensated to perform landscaping work, to knowingly leave tree trimmings, shrubs, brush, plants and/or landscaping materials for pickup by the city, or to deposit these items on open lots (public or private), city streets, or other property.

Pickup service will not be provided if trash is improperly placed, deemed unsafe to collect, or contains unacceptable items.

Solid Waste collection services are provided only to an address with an active service account.
