It flows untreated through the **storm drain system**, eventually reaching our rivers, washes, and retention areas. **Commercial automotive businesses** must follow the law to properly dispose of these dangerous environmental pollutants.

Proper cleanup and disposal of chemicals is required by municipal, state, and federal authorities.

FOLLOW BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES (BMPs):



Use a dry cleanup method for spills. Do not hose down.



Have a spill prevention plan and ensure proper employee training.



Keep anything stored outside under cover.



Schedule routine cleaning for slop sinks and trench drains.
