

Summer Recreation Program Q & A

1. Where and how can I register my child(ren)?

- a. Online or In-person registration only at the Goodyear Recreation Campus.
 - i. Goodyear residents are able to register for Summer Recreation beginning Monday, April 3 at 6:00 a.m.
 - ii. Non-residents are eligible to register beginning Wednesday, April 5 at 6:00 a.m., where space is available.

2. Which Summer Recreation locations will be offered for summer of 2023?

- a. Copper Trails Elementary: 16875 W Canyon Trails Blvd, Goodyear, AZ, 85338
- b. Centerra Mirage Stem Academy: 15151 W. Centerra Dr, Goodyear, AZ 85338
- c. Trivium Preparatory Academy: 2001 N Bullard Ave, Goodyear, AZ, 85395

Camp X-Treme Drop-In Summer Recreation

- d. Basis Charter School: 15800 W Sherman St, Goodyear, AZ, 85338

3. What is the difference between Camp X-Treme recreation camp from the other locations?

- i. Camp X-Treme site will NOT have the traditional activities such as arts & crafts, coloring, board games.
- ii. Camp X-Treme site will be highly active.
- iii. Camp X-Treme site will be attending the Goodyear Recreation Campus Pool 1-2 times a week.

4. What are the ages for this year's Summer Recreation Camps?

- a. The traditional summer recreation sites ages are 6-12 yrs. (participant must have completed Kindergarten)
- b. Camp X-Treme site ages will be 8-12 yrs.

5. What are this year's program dates/hours for all camps?

- a. All summer recreation camps will begin Monday, June 5 and end Friday, July 21. (7 Weeks)
 - i. The traditional summer recreation sites will be from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
 - a. AM Half-Day Program will run from 7:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
 - b. PM Half-Day Program will run from 12:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.
 - ii. Camp X-Treme summer recreation will be from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

6. Will there be any half day/weekly programs available?

- a. Yes, the traditional sites will offer half-day programs only.
- b. Camp X-Treme will not have a half-day option.

7. What is the cost for this year's summer recreation program?

- a. Summer Recreation Camp's
 - i. Residents \$320
 - ii. Non-Residents \$385
- b. Half Day (Traditional sites only)
 - i. Residents \$180
 - ii. Non-Residents \$220

8. Is there multiple children discounts?

- a. Only Goodyear residents will be eligible for multi-child discounts.
 - i. Full Program Resident Option
 - a. 2 Children: PLUS1
 - i. -\$40.00 Per Child
 - b. 3 + Children: 3PLUS
 - i. -80.00 Per Child
 - ii. Half Day Resident Option
 - a. 2 Children: PLUS1
 - i. -\$22.50 Per Child
 - b. 3 + Children: 3PLUS
 - i. -\$45.00 Per Child
- b. Field Trip pack is excluded from discounts.

9. When is the last day to register and/or receive a refund?

- a. Last day to register
 - i. Friday, June 2 or until the program is full
- b. Last day for Refunds
 - i. Friday, June 2. If there is a refund during camp, there will be a pro-rated refund

10. Will there be payment plans available?

- a. Yes, a minimum of \$50 per child is required at the time of registration
- b. Final payment must be made by Friday, May 26 by 5:00pm

11. Will there be a waiting list?

- a. Yes, you will be put on a waiting list and will be called or emailed when a spot is available to register.

12. Will there be field trips this summer?

- a. Yes, there will be 5 field trips including the Goodyear Recreation Center pool, Uptown Jungle, Harkins Theater, Main Event & Fat Cats.

13. What is the cost for this year's field trip package?

- a. Optional Field Trip Package
 - i. Residents \$70
 - ii. Non-Residents \$85
- b. Optional field trip package is ONLY available if registered for the full day program.

14. If we are running late for a field trip, can I drop my child(ren) off at the field trip location?

- a. We prefer that all participants attending the field trips are dropped off at their summer recreation location at the specified time before going on the trip.
- b. Due to safety protocols, we would like for all participants arriving to and from with our transportation busses with all field trips.

15. What is the staff/participant ratio?

- a. There will be a 15-20 participant per 1 staff ratio.
- b. There will be a Maximum of 120 participants for the three traditional summer recreation sites.
- c. Camp X-Treme will be one site with 75 participants.

16. What happens if I'm late to pick up my child?

3 Traditional Sites

- a. A \$10.00 late fee per child will be assessed at the following rates: 5:31-5:45 p.m. (\$10.00); 5:46-6:00 p.m. (\$20.00); 6:01-6:15 p.m. (\$30.00); etc. Pick-up time will be recorded by the designated site clock.

Camp X-Treme

- b. A \$10.00 late fee per child will be assessed at the following rates: 3:31-3:45 p.m. (\$10.00); 3:46-4:00 p.m. (\$20.00); 4:01-4:15 p.m. (\$30.00); etc. Pick-up time will be recorded by the designated site clock.

17. Could any child sign in/out at any time as they please?

- a. A: YES, this program is considered a "Drop in Summer Program" labeled by the state, which children can come in/out as they please.

18. How will Participant check in/out take place?

- a. There will be a recreation tent outside each location with staff signing in children one by one
- b. Pickup will be conducted by calling the number for each site.

19. What is Healthy Verify Certification?

- a. The city of Goodyear has contracted with Healthy Verify to help provide modifications and develop safety standards for re-opening programs. Protocols will help reduce the risk of disease transmission at facilities and programs while trying to instill confidence in employees and participants.

20. What precautions will staff be taking due to COVID-19?

- a. Hand sanitizer and gloves will be available in each activity room.
- b. All staff will be required to sanitize all frequently touched areas between group rotations.
- c. Staff will exercise social distancing guidelines. (6-Feet)
- d. To limit exposure, parents will not be allowed in at any summer recreation locations. All site phone numbers will be available to parents to contact a site lead any time.
- e. Each night custodial services will take place at each location for full sanitizing.

21. What happens if a participant or staff gets sick during program hours?

- a. Any staff or participant that appear to have symptoms such as a fever, coughing, or trouble breathing, will be separated from others and will be sent home immediately. Staff must be cleared by a doctor before returning to work.
