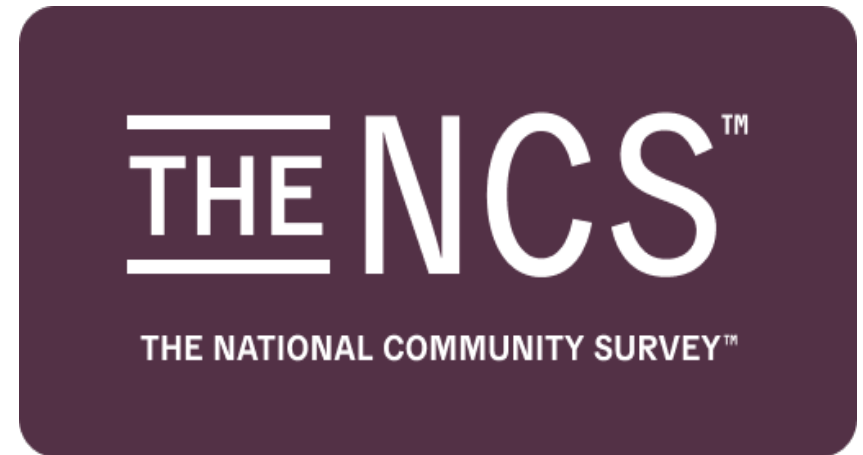

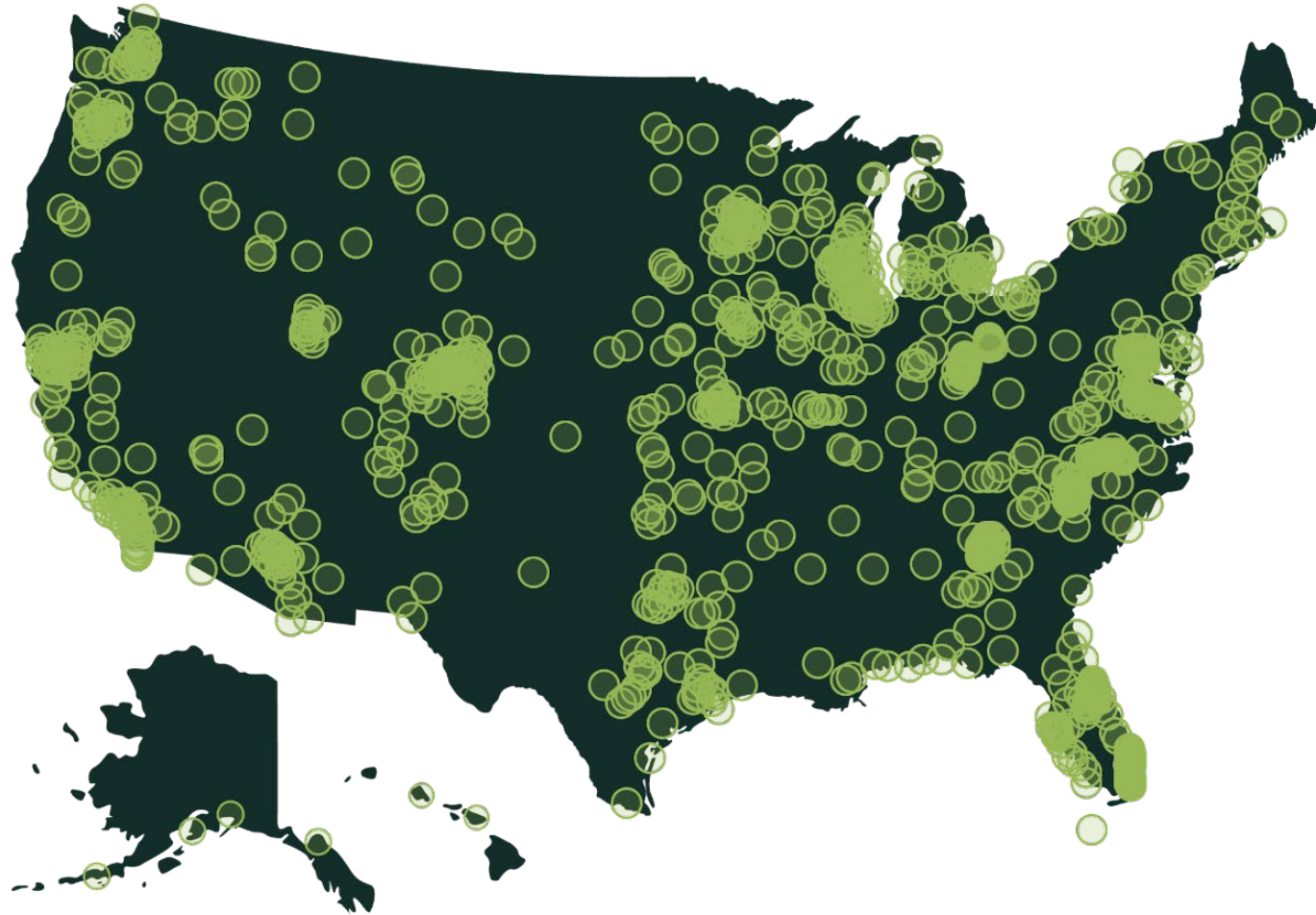


The National Community Survey™ in Goodyear

The NCS™ for Goodyear, AZ

- Fifth time conducting The NCS (previous surveys in 2013, 2015, 2018, 2021)
- Survey conducted from March 17th – April 28th
- Mailing approach employed:
 - Probability-based sample of 3,200 randomly selected households
 - 404 total responses received
 - 13% overall response rate
 - Non-probability, open-participation survey: 362 responses
- Results statistically weighted to reflect Goodyear overall
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 5% margin of error

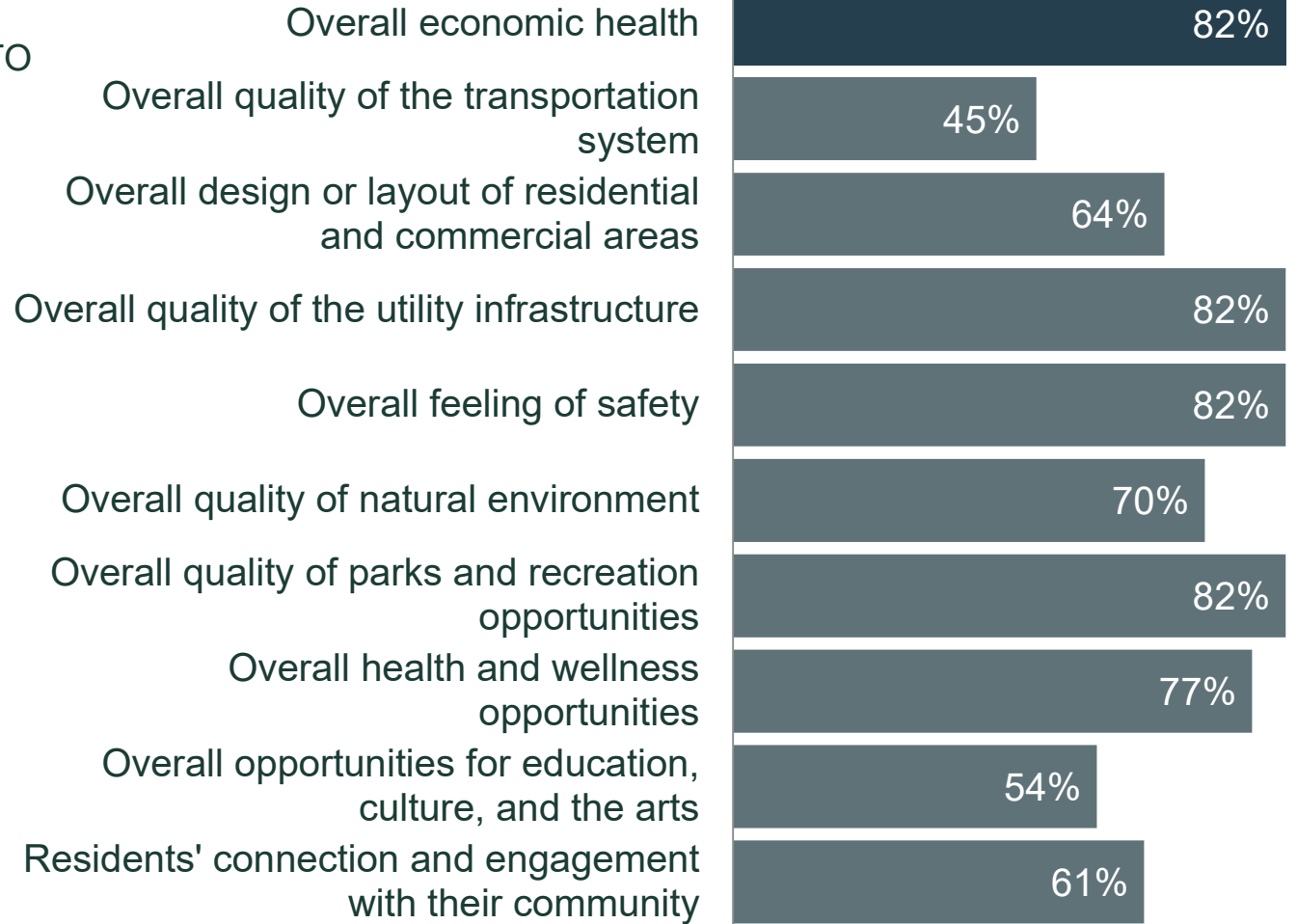

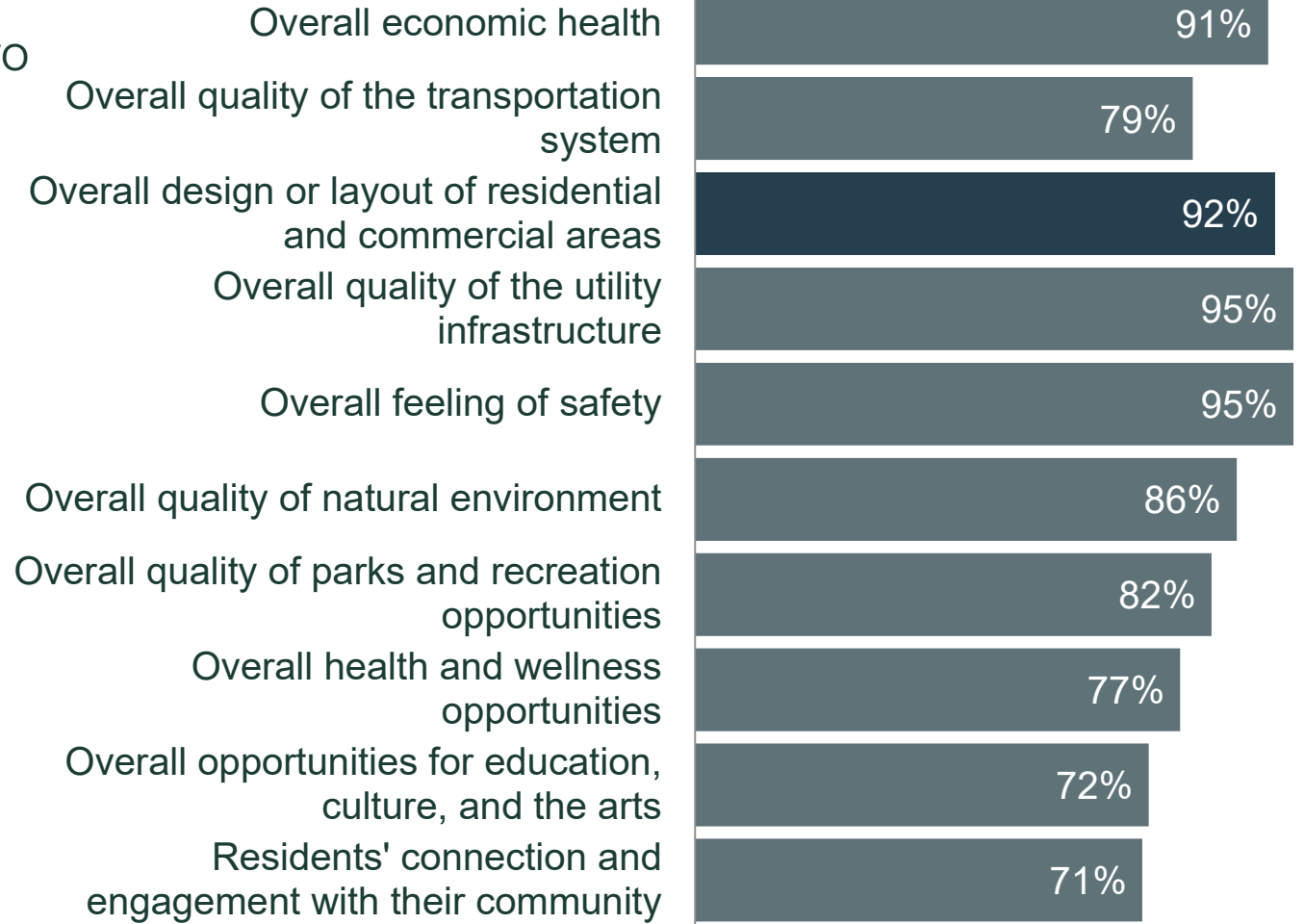

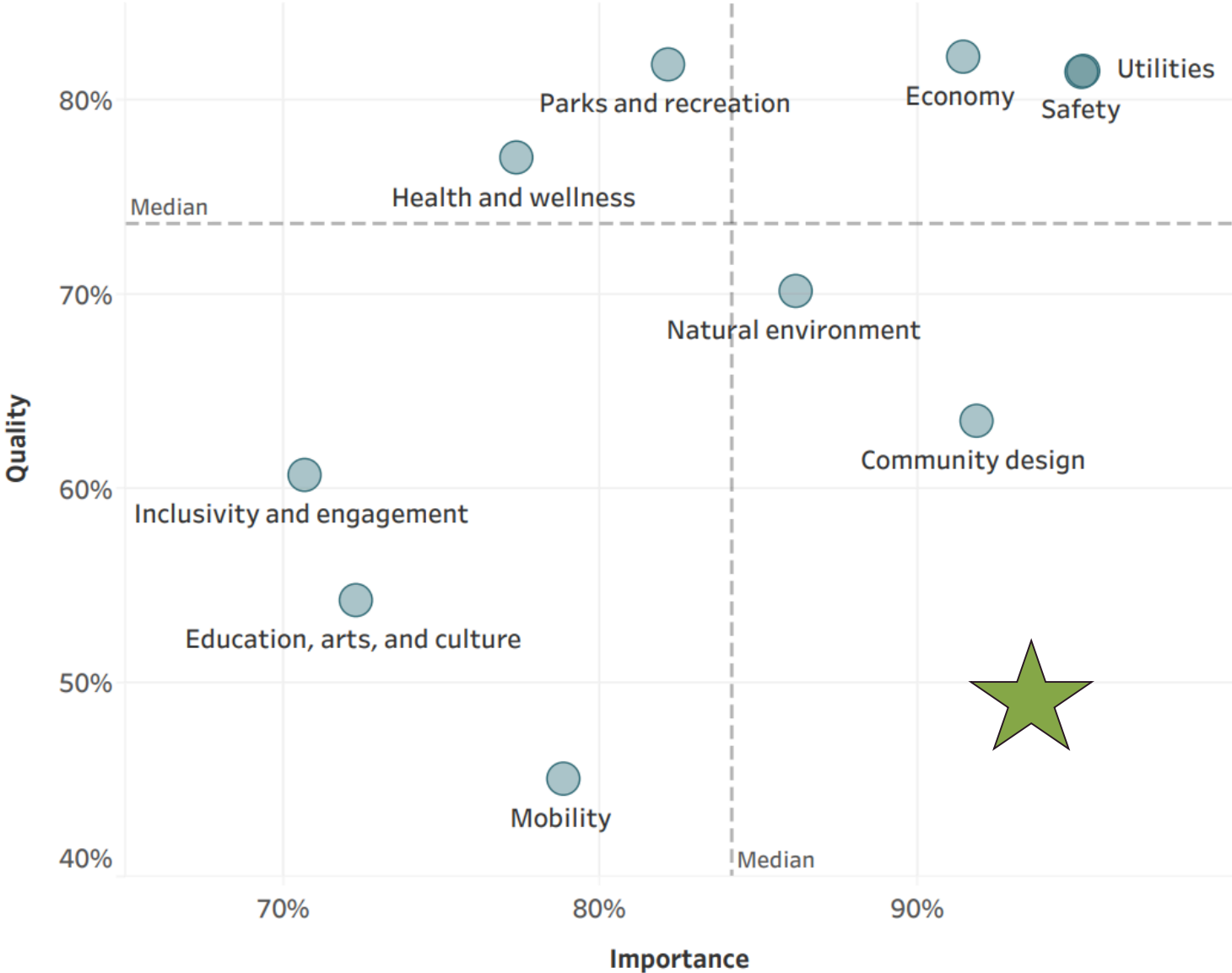

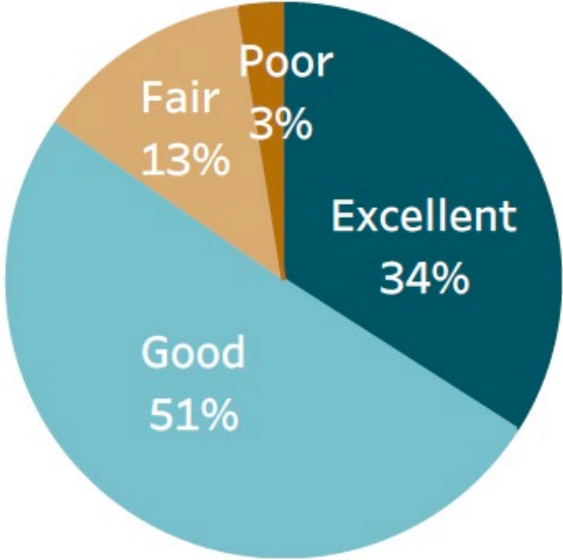

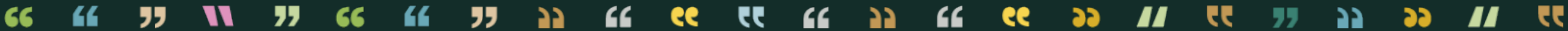
The overall quality of life in Goodyear, 2023



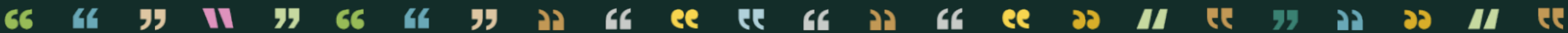
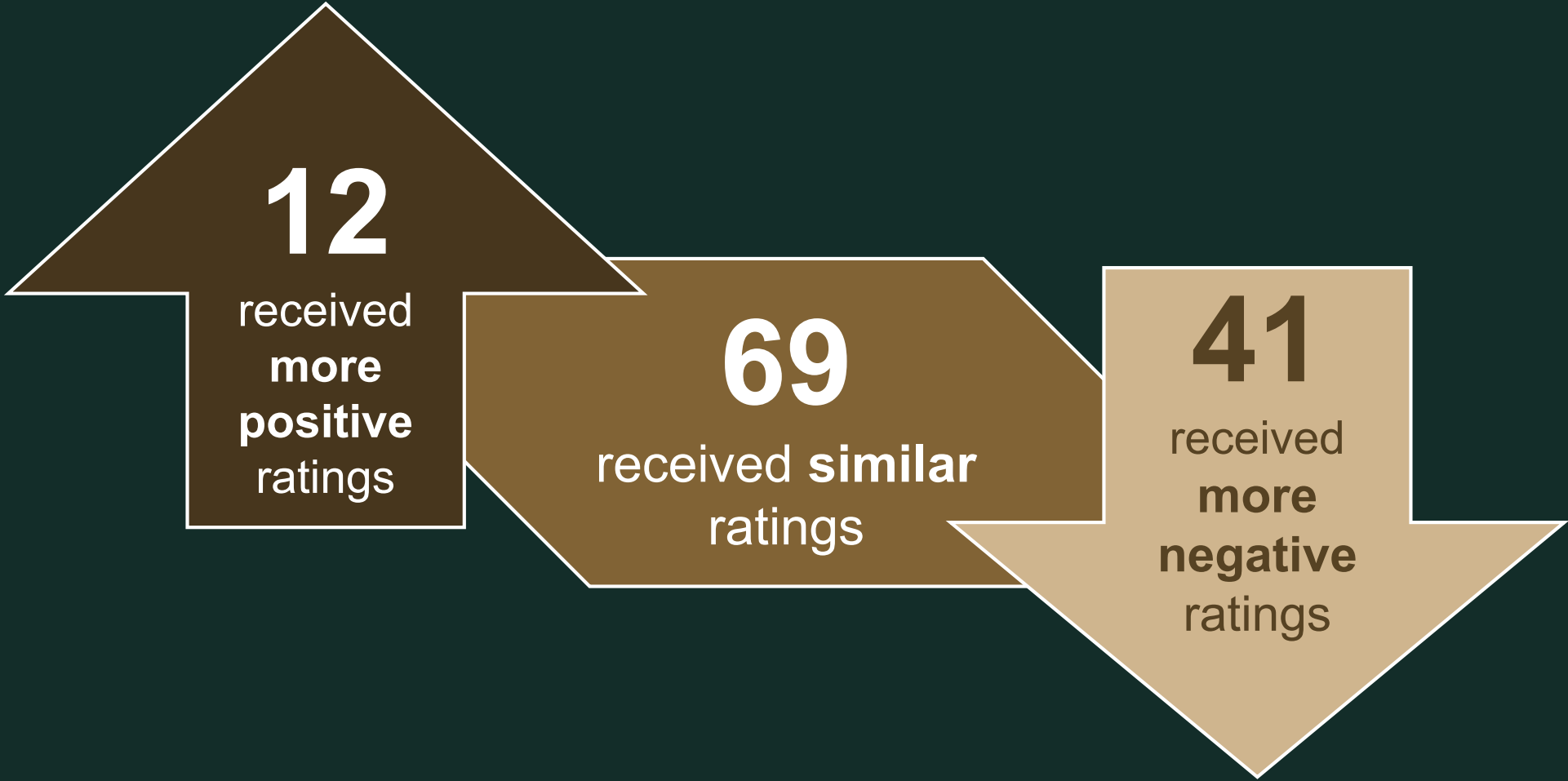

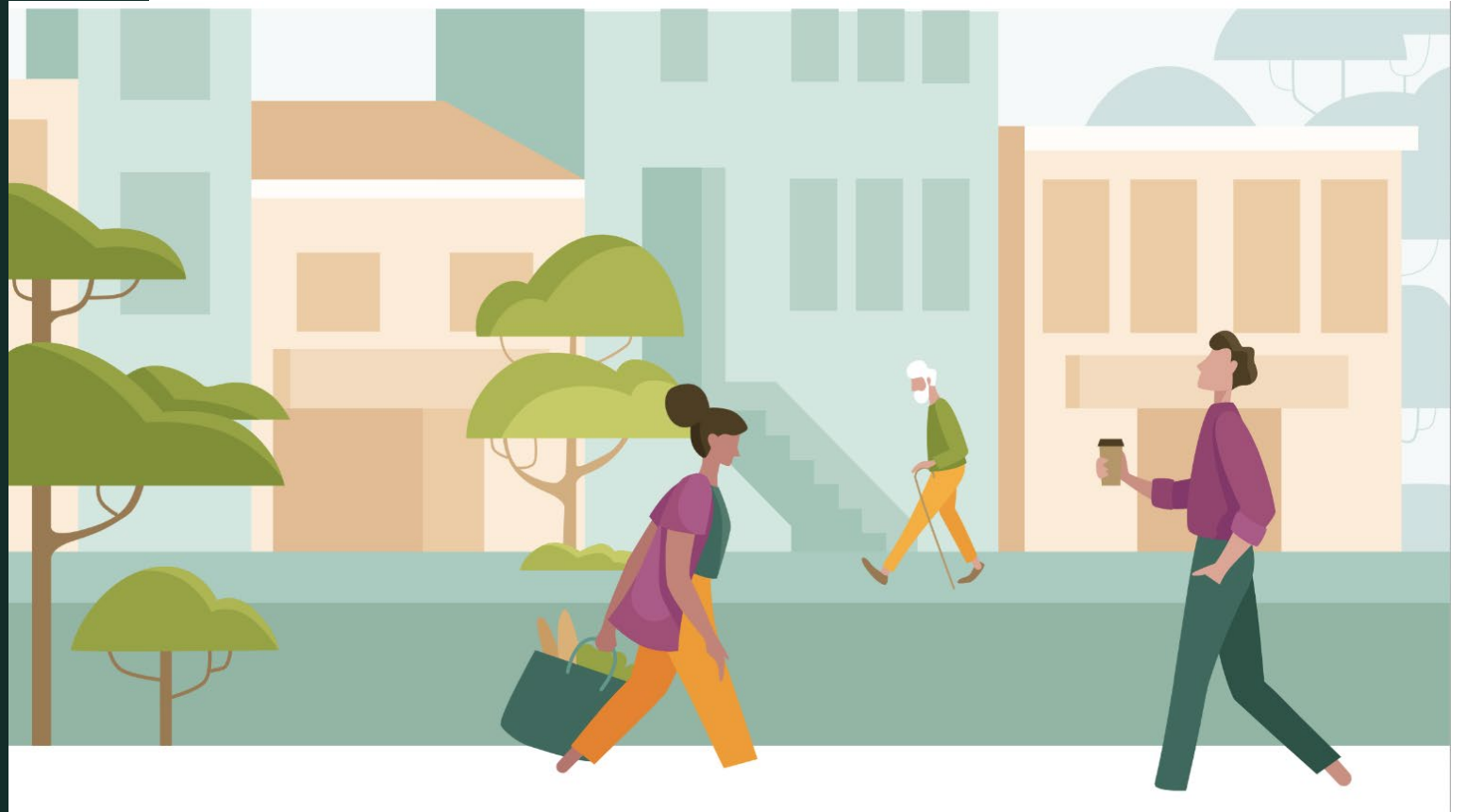
Comparisons from 2021 year to 2023

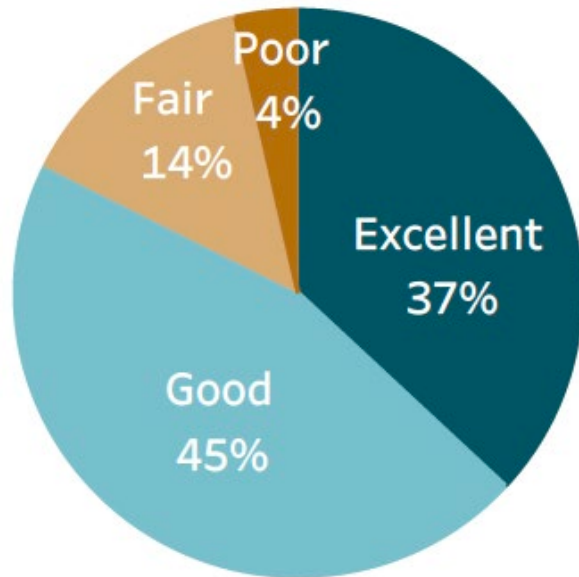

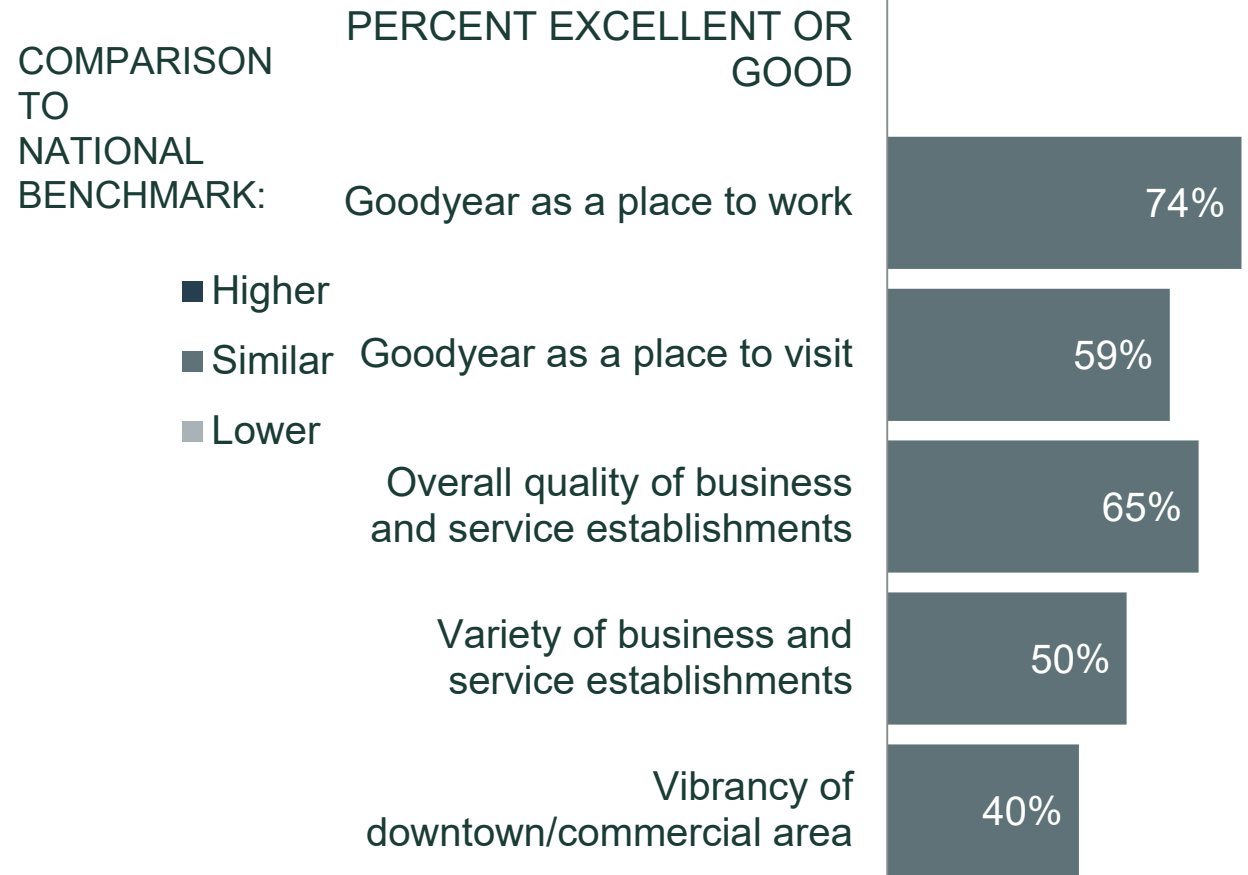
The Economy in Goodyear



Overall economic health of Goodyear, 2023



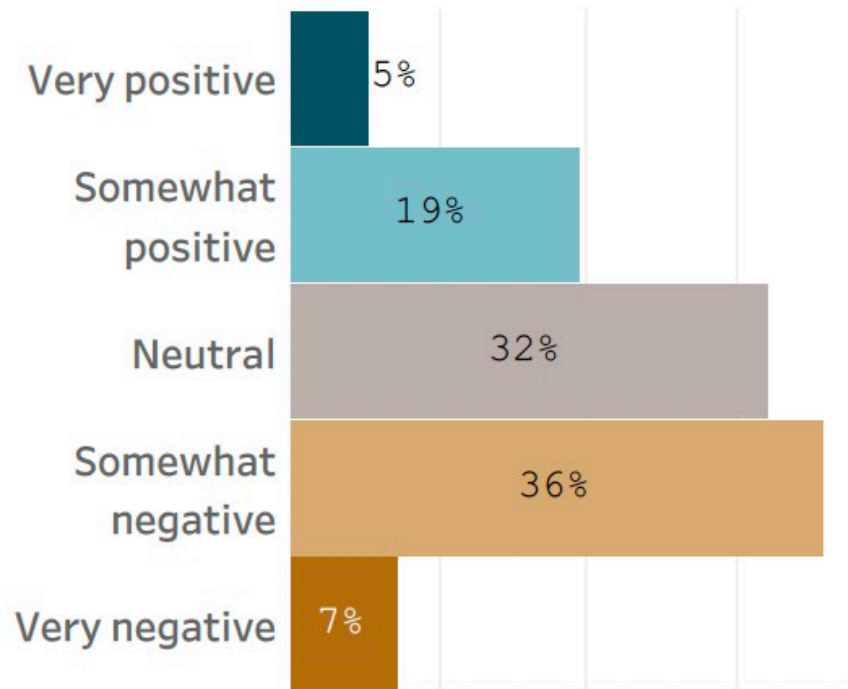

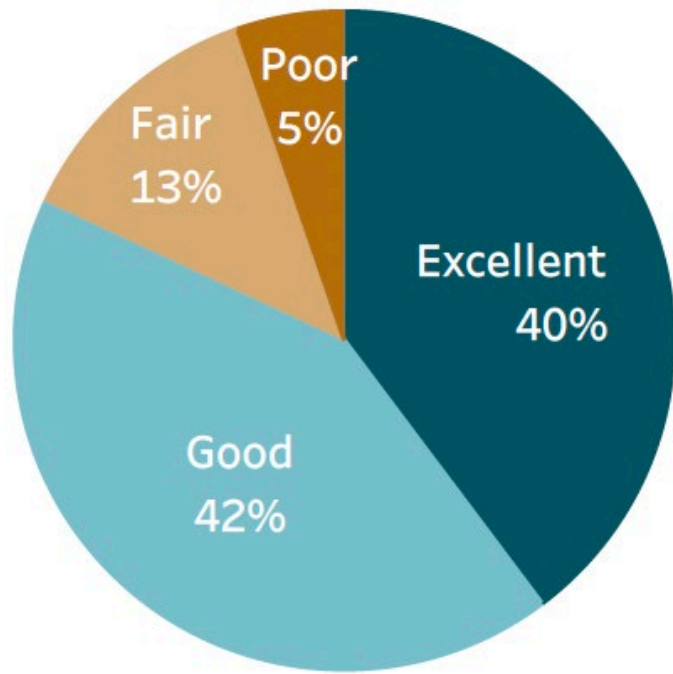

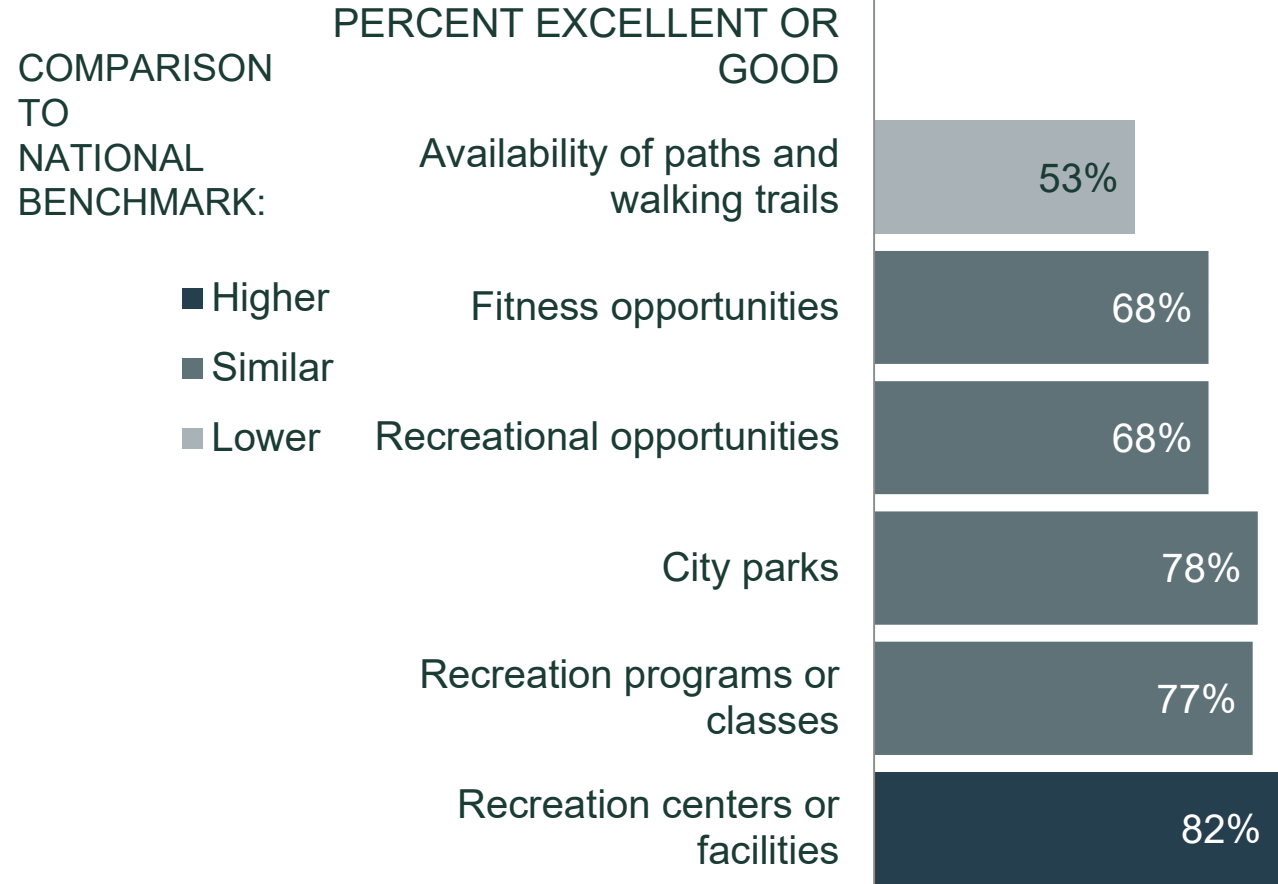
Parks and Recreation in Goodyear



Overall quality of parks and recreation opportunities, 2023



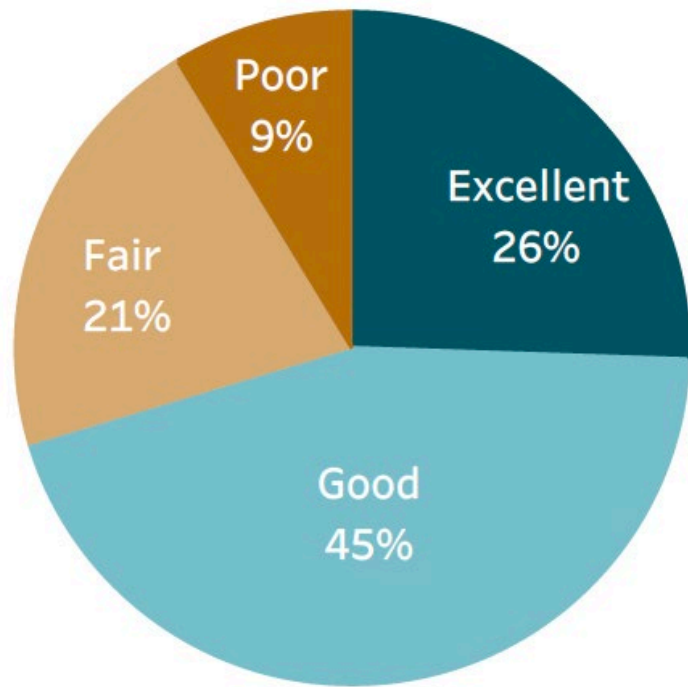

Overall quality of natural environment in Goodyear, 2023

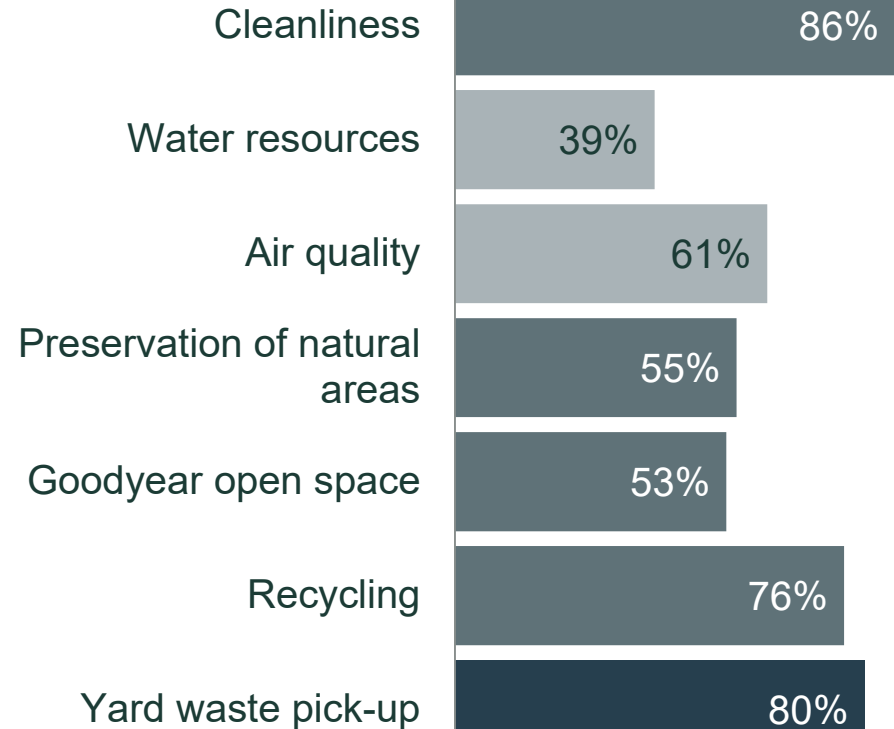

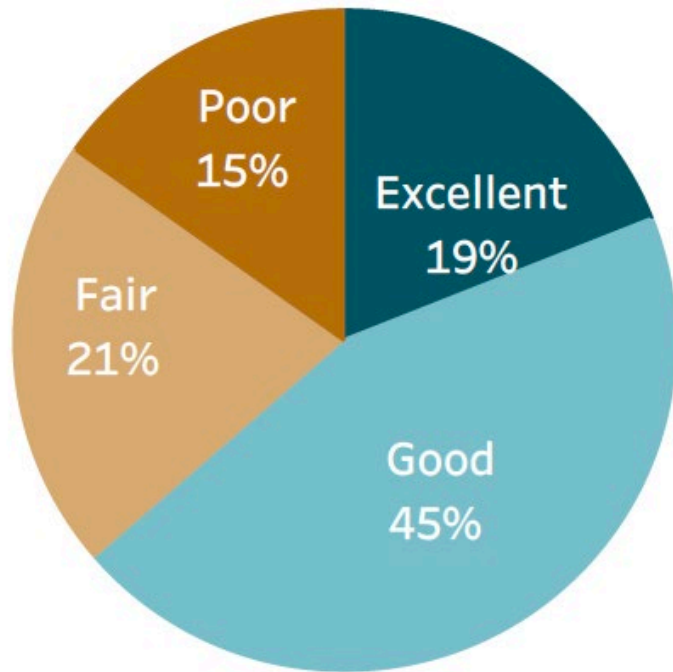

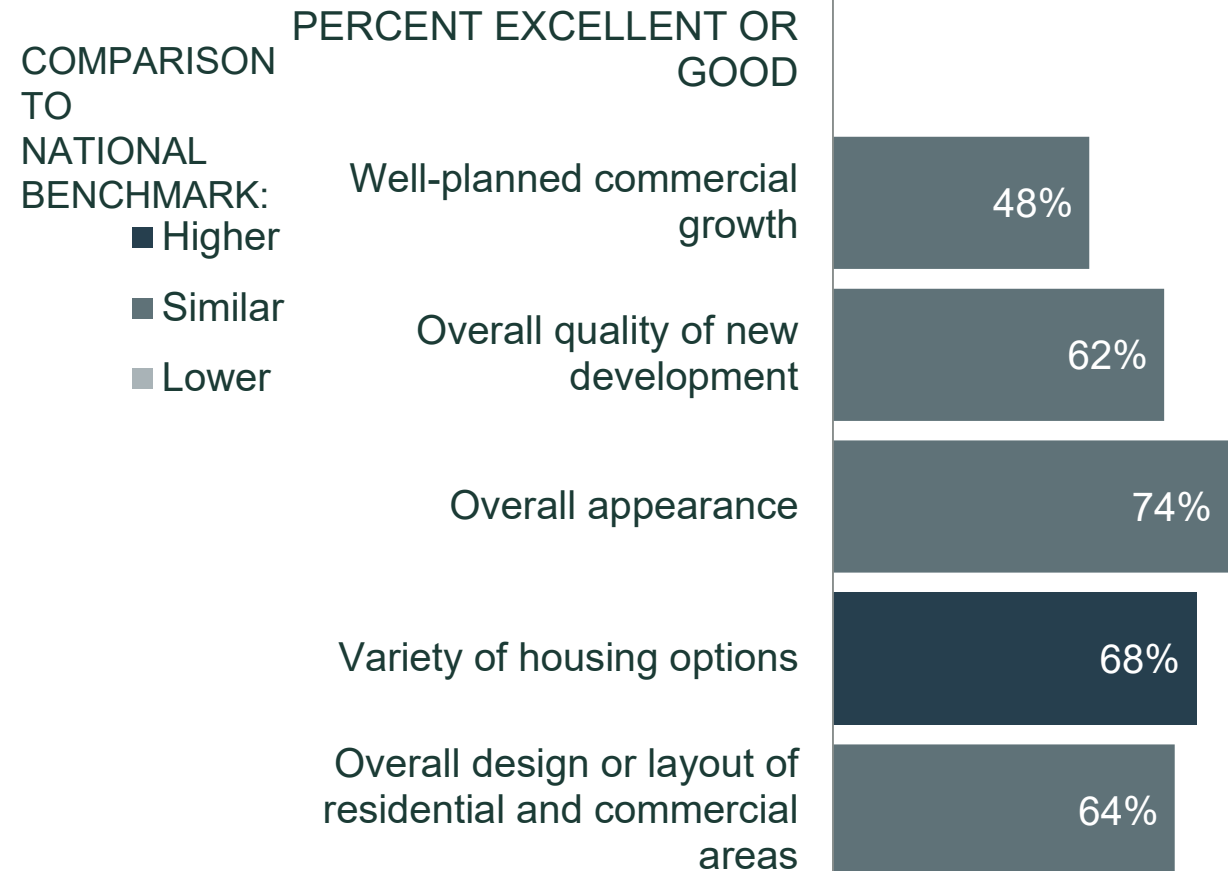
Community Design in Goodyear

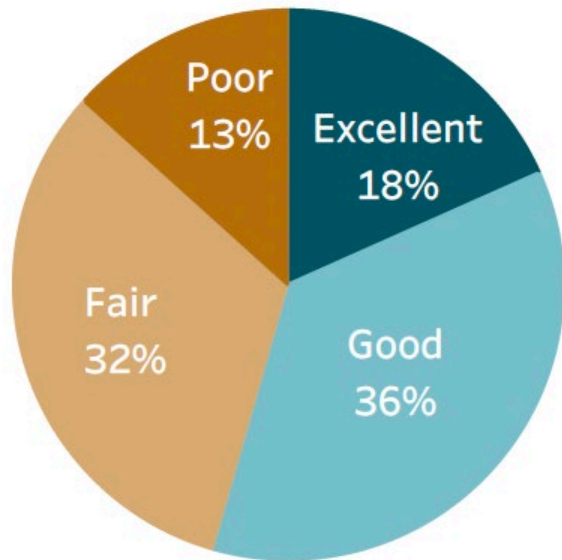

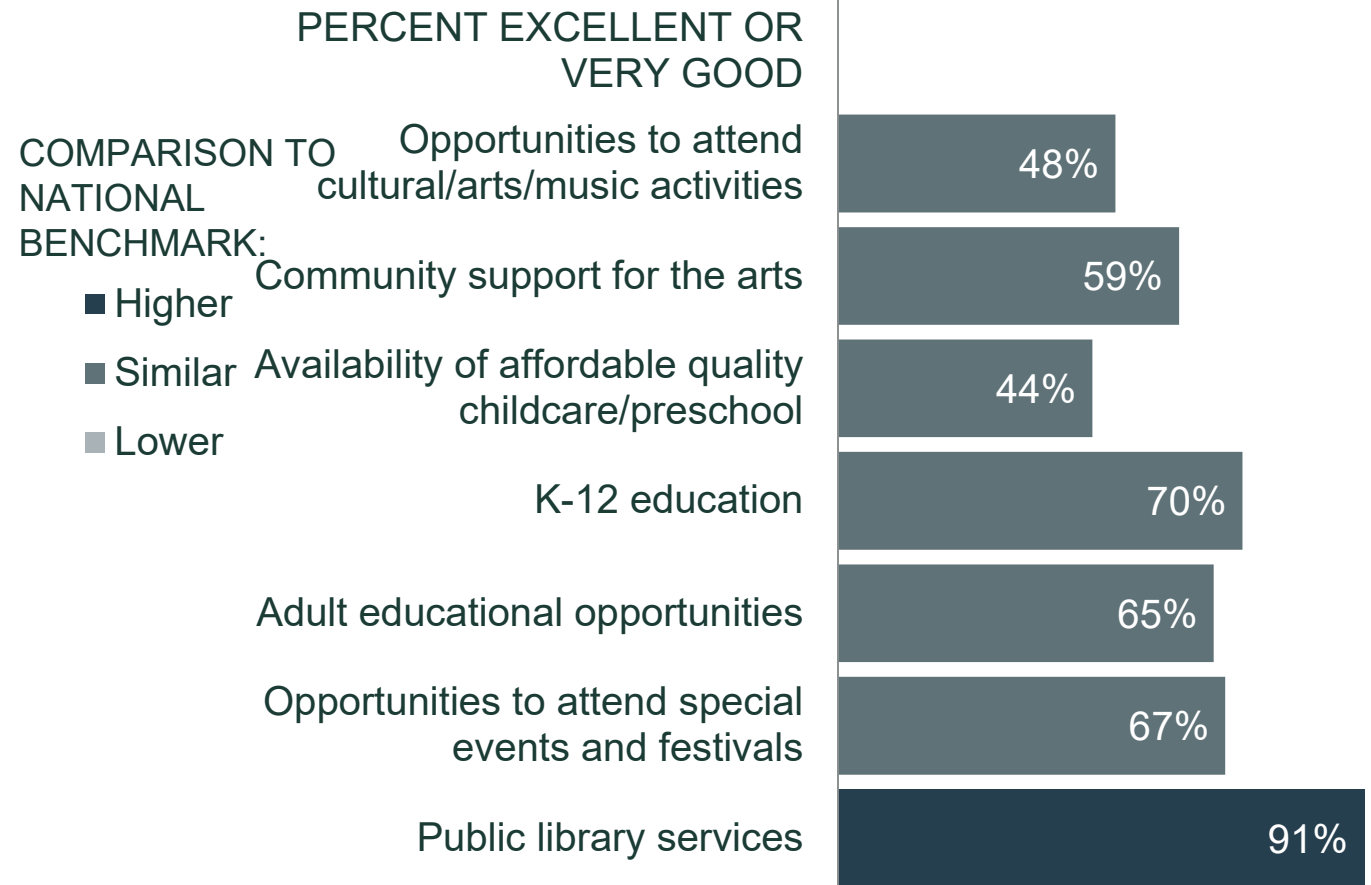
Education, Arts, and Culture in Goodyear

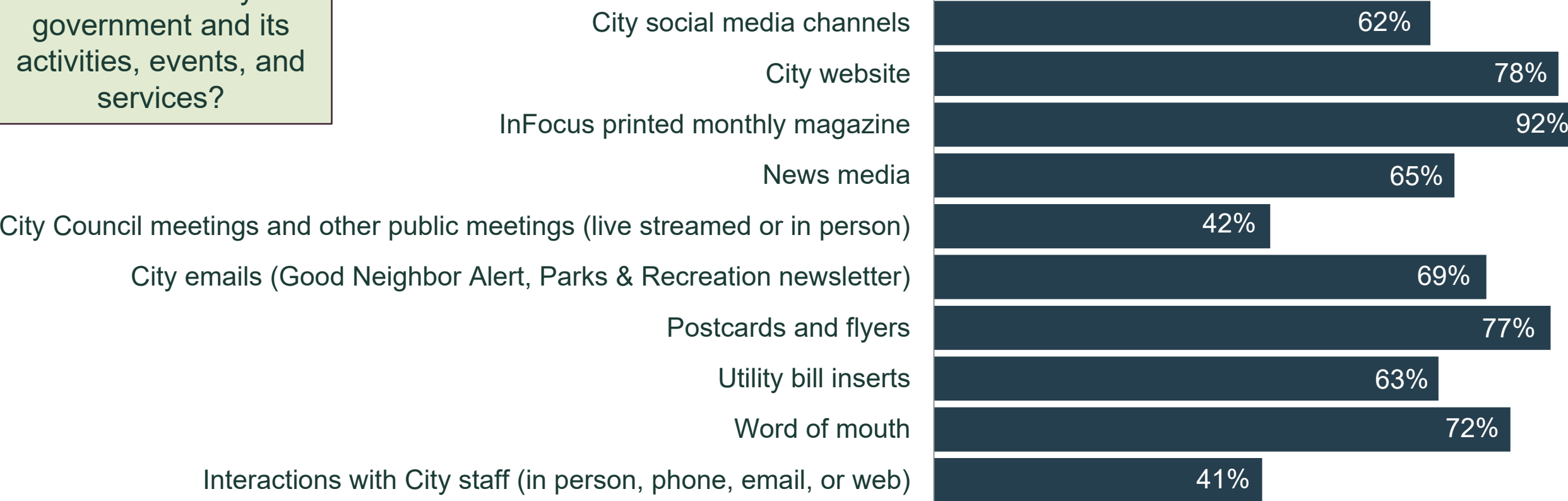

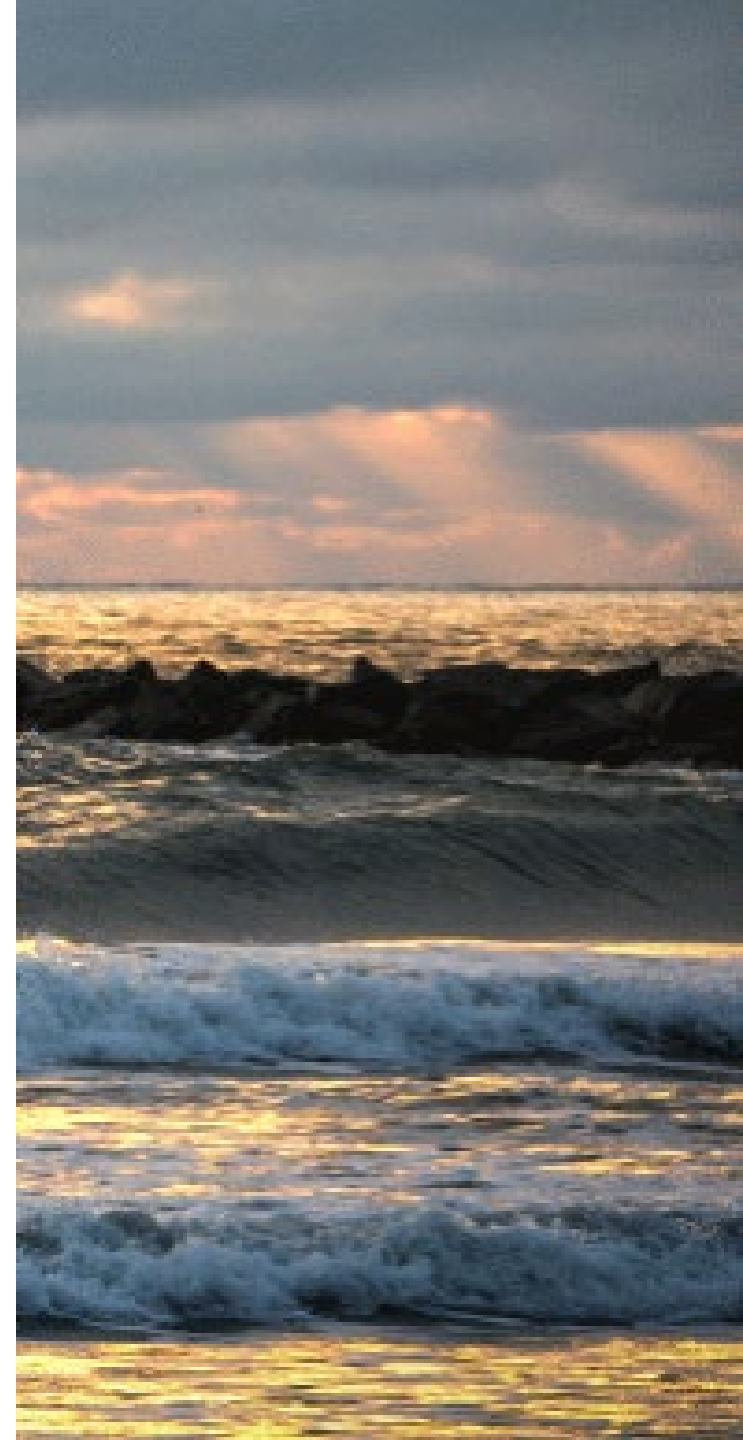
