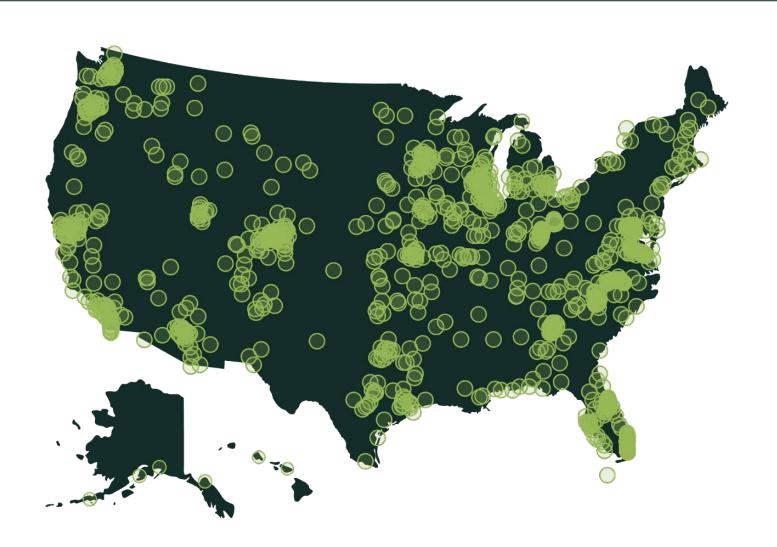
## The National Community Survey TM in Goodyear

#### The NCS™ for Goodyear, AZ

- Fifth time conducting The NCS (previous surveys in 2013, 2015, 2018, 2021)
- Survey conducted from March 17th April 28th
- Mailing approach employed:
  - Probability-based sample of 3,200 randomly selected households
  - 404 total responses received
  - 13% overall response rate
  - Non-probability, open-participation survey: 362 responses
- Results statistically weighted to reflect Goodyear overall
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 5% margin of error

Representing the opinions of more than <u>50 million</u> residents.



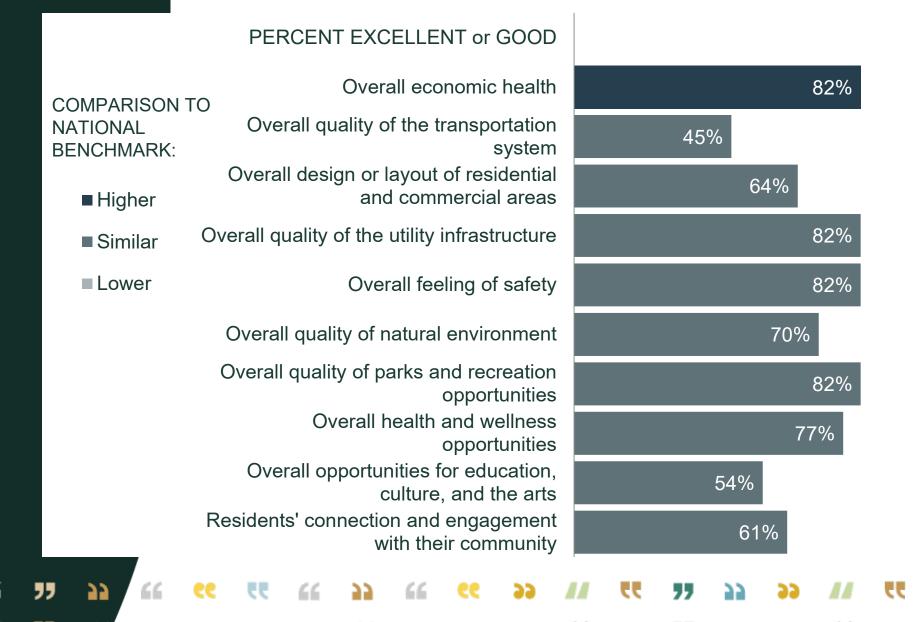

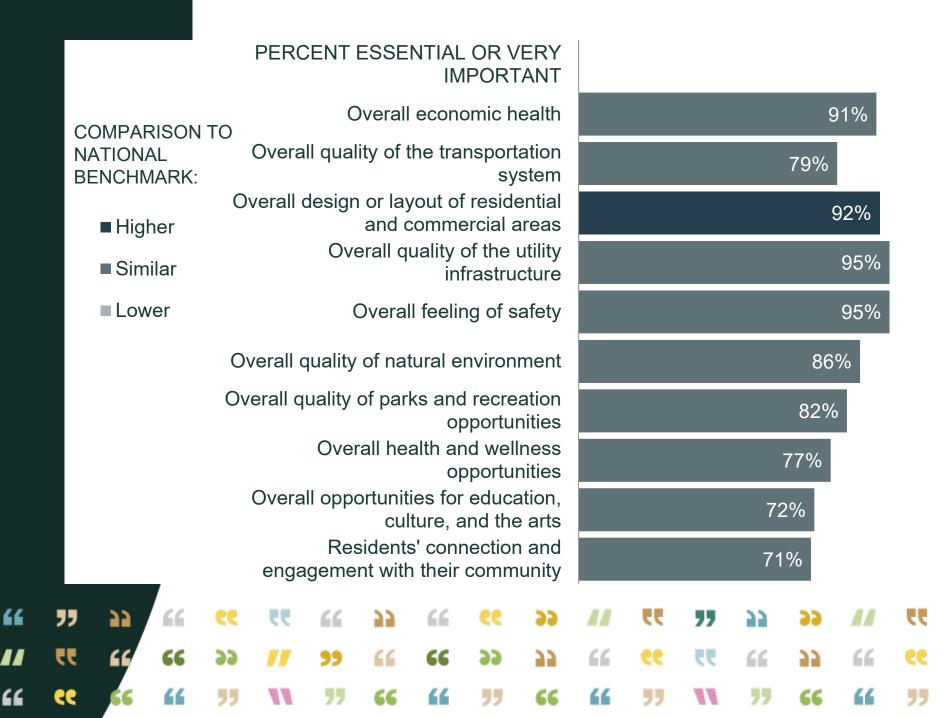

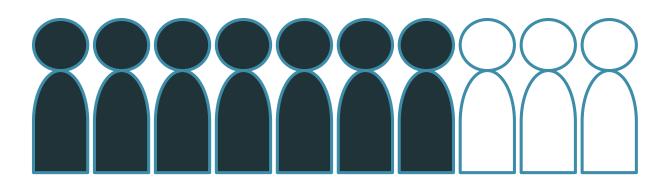

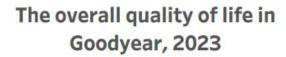

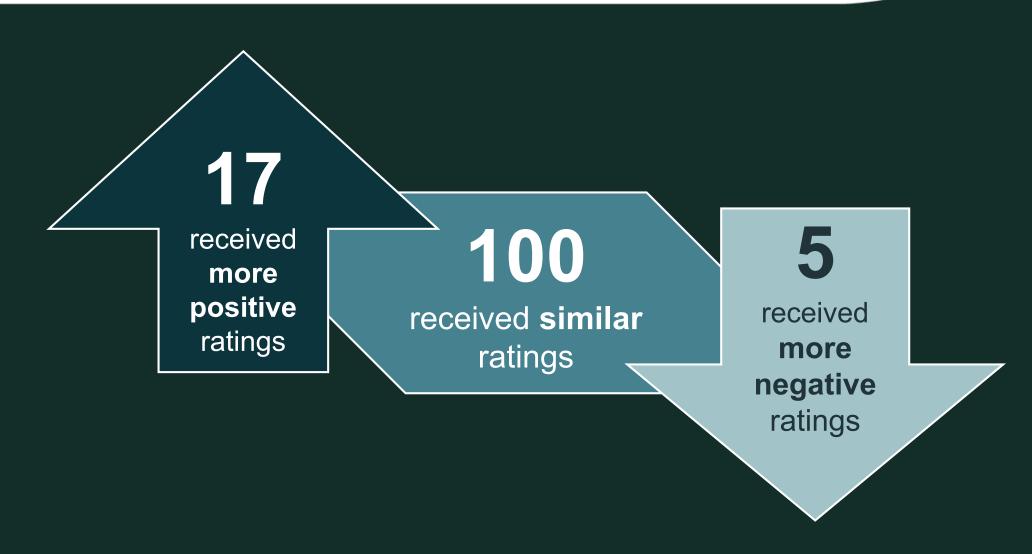

#### Comparisons from 2021 year to 2023





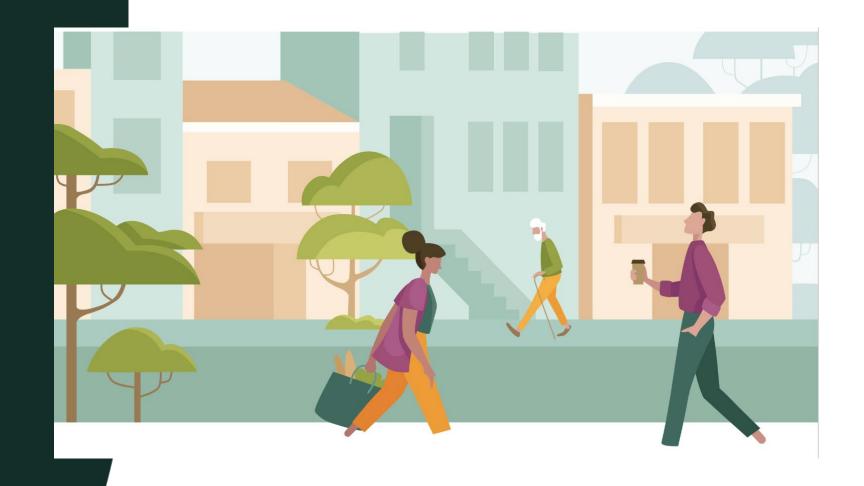

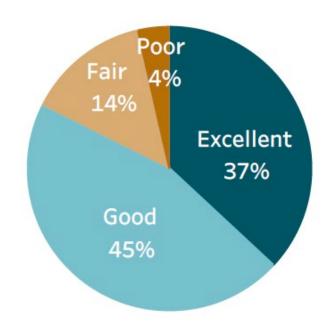

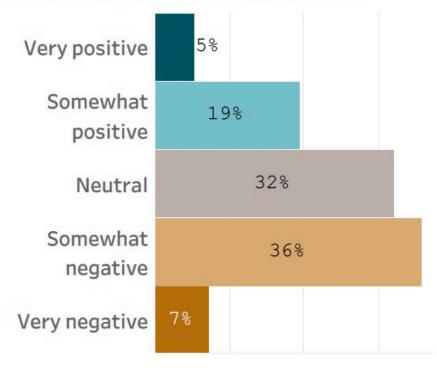

What impact, if any, do you think the economy will have on your family income in the next 6 months? Do you think the impact will be:

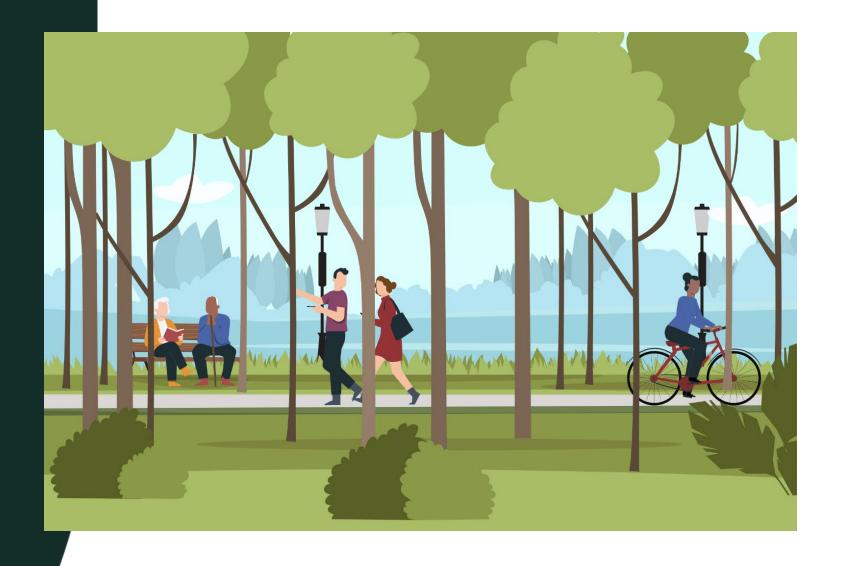

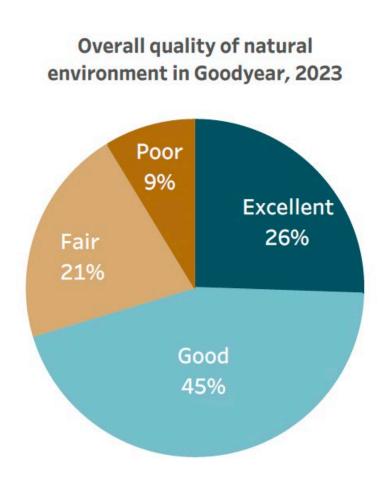

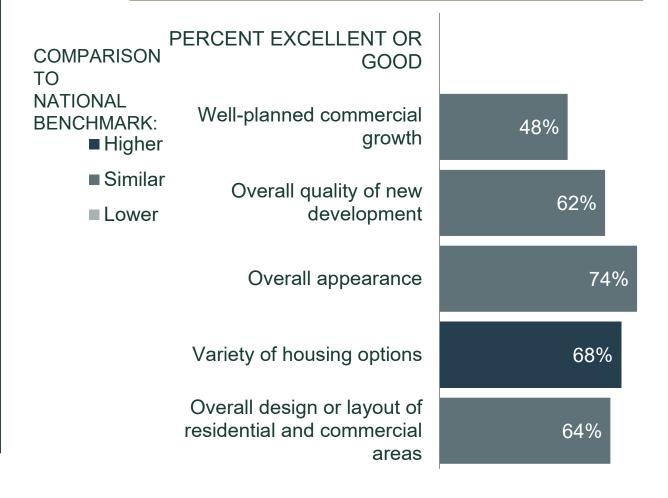
