DID YOU KNOW?



Improper disposal of **Fats, Oils, & Grease** is harmful to your home's plumbing system and to the public sanitary sewer system.

PROPER DISPOSAL IS EASY: **POUR, SCRAPE, TOSS**

POUR cooled oil into a sealable, disposable container.

SCRAPE cooled grease into a sealable, disposable container.

TOSS food scraps in the kitchen trash, instead of using the garbage disposal.



Bag & tie ALL trash, including FOG containers, before disposing into your tan trash can.

All of these items clog pipes when disposed of improperly. These substances contribute to build up in the sanitary sewer system, constricting flow, which can result in smelly overflow discharges onto streets and costly sewer backups and repairs to homeowner's.
