

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-2382**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR THE FY24 EDWARD BYRNE GRANT FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING TO SAID APPLICATIONS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT (IF GRANT FUNDS ARE AWARDED), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE THE REQUIRED BUDGET TRANSFER (IF GRANT FUNDS ARE AWARDED).

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to apply for the Edward Byrne grant funds for assistance in training officers in understanding the dynamics of human conflict; and

WHEREAS, the training qualifies as eligible projects under the Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, there is no match requirement for this application; and

WHEREAS, the any member of the public may speak on any item on the agenda; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement with the Department of Justice to implement the projects or programs that have been approved by the for the Edward Byrne grant.
- SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all documents relating to this grant offer.
- SECTION 3. The City Council hereby approves necessary budget transfers in the amount of the awarded funds.
