Pre-Application and Due Diligence Meeting Guide

- **Pre-Application Meeting**: A Pre-Application Meeting is required prior to submitting a development application for no fee. Submittal checklists will be provided following the Pre-Application meeting.
- **Due Diligence Meeting**: The City will provide general guidance regarding a potential project's viability for no fee. There is nothing required for this meeting, but the more information provided in the application, the better we can help you. Please use this link to view Fact Sheets for select sites.

Items to keep in mind when scheduling:

- Pre-Application and Due Diligence Meetings are conducted on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons in 45-minute increments between the hours of 1:30-4:30 P.M.
- Meetings are scheduled first come, first serve.
- Meetings may not be held on Holiday weeks.

Required Documents:

- For Commercial, Industrial, Multi-family (including single-family rentals) New Ground

 acceptable, otherwise please include:
 - ☑ <u>Project Narrative</u> Should include a description of the project and specific questions for staff comment (Can include project and process questions)
 - ☑ Aerial Vicinity Map
 - ☑ Conceptual Site Plan Should show or provide the following information:
 - ☑ Proposed building location(s), height, square footage, and occupancy
 - Building setbacks and heights
 - Existing and proposed driveway locations
 - ☑ Number and location of proposed parking spaces
 - ☑ Proposed project phasing
 - □ Conceptual Building Elevations
- For Single-family Residential projects If you are at the rezoning stage of a site, conceptual plans are acceptable, otherwise please include:
 - ☑ <u>Project Narrative</u> Should include a description of the project and specific questions for staff comment (Can include project and process questions)
 - ☑ Aerial Vicinity Map
 - ☑ Conceptual Subdivision Plat Should show or provide the following information:
 - ☑ Density and number of lots
 - Lot size and dimensions
 - Existing and proposed street
 - ☑ Proposed open space/landscaping
 - ☑ Proposed project phasing
