A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE KING RANCH COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT (CITY OF GOODYEAR, ARIZONA) APPROVING THE FINAL BUDGET OF THE DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2025.

Civic Square, Goodyear, Arizona, for the purposes of conducting a hearing on the District Budget attached hereto as <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> and incorporated by reference herein, and on the tax levy; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Title 48, Section 716, Arizona Revised Statutes, and following public notice, the District Board met on June 10, 2024, at which hearing any taxpayer in the District was permitted to appear and be heard in favor or against any of the proposed expenditures or tax levies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE KING RANCH COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT (CITY OF GOODYEAR, ARIZONA) that the District Budget in the amount of \$18,400 is hereby adopted as the District Budget of the District for fiscal year 2025.
