

Construction Notice:

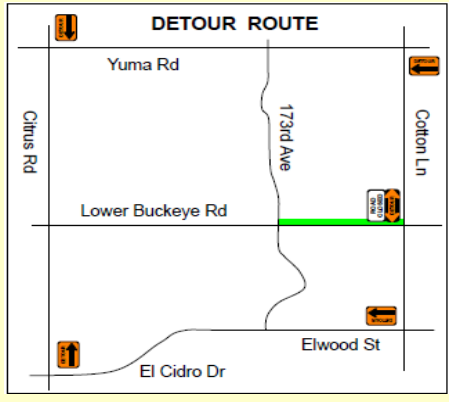
The City of Goodyear Public Works Department will be performing a Mill and Overlay project on Lower Buckeye Road from Cotton Lane to 173rd Ave. Project duration is anticipated to be November 11th - 19th.

Lower Buckeye Road project will be a Mill and Overlay treatment, in which the first 1.5 inches of pavement will be milled off and replaced with 1.5 inches of fresh asphalt. This is commonly used on roads where the surface has deteriorated to a point where other treatments are no longer effective. This will extend the useful life of the pavement and reset the treatment cycle of the roadway.

You will see construction equipment and crews of ViaSun, the contractor to the City on this project.
